Data separation – remarkably simple

CIM GmbH Logistics Systems will present the new PROLAG® World 2.1 at the transport logistic trade exhibition (12-15 June in Munich; Hall 4C, Stand 324). The six software modules–WMS, Controlling, Monitoring, Billing, Shipping and Customs–are complemented by features to simplify the task of client administration; these will be presented to logistics service providers at transport logistic. “Out client separation enables data to be divided flexibly to suit the warehouse architecture. Division may be according to customer, location or owner,” explained Dipl.-Ing Fritz Mayr.

Client Concept brings Clarity

The need to separate data by client (i.e. owner) continues to increase in importance, especially for logistics service providers (3rd party logistics). “Empty warehouse space means higher costs. If free space is to be rented flexibly to new customers, there needs to be a clear separation of data,” Mayr explained. The new CIM client concept ensures that the customer has access via a web portal only to their own goods. The service provider may manage the entire warehouse using a super-client with access to all client data. This client concept forms the basis of an effective Vendor Managed Inventory (VMI). PROLAG® World allows a straightforward division by location. Within each location, items are further differentiated by article and customer, order and owner.

Podium Discussion: Warehouse Concepts for Dynamic Markets

On July 12th from 1:30pm until 3pm, a podium discussion will examine "Warehouse Concepts for Dynamic Markets" (Forum III, Hall 4C). Chaired by Prof. Williband Günther (Technical University, Munich) and Prof. Michael ten Hompel (Fraunhofer IML), Fritz Mayr will be present as a WMS expert. Also taking part will be Jens Fankhänel (Dematic GmbH), Jens-David Attal (Savoye) and Jan Schmidt (i+o GmbH & Co. KG).
